- Some initial experience in working with various stakeholders including large companies, small and medium enterprises, NGOs, financing institutions, government aid agencies, smallholders or local communities;
- Working knowledge of another language (especially French, Spanish, Portuguese or Bahasa) would be a strong advantage.
